The field of commodities includes a very large spectrum of differently composed matrices (e.g. glassware, ceramics, wood, metal, leather, textiles, plastics like PE, PP, PA, PES, PVC and chemicals) - meaning an analytical challenge.

Complex legal regulations:

Assessments concerning health and consumer risks have to take European and national law into consideration (e.g. foodstuff, chemical and product safety law).

The working group is a neutral **committee**, who offers expert advice to manufacturers, commerce and official services. Recently there are 42 members (18 active, 24 corresponding). The **members** are chemists and food chemists from:
