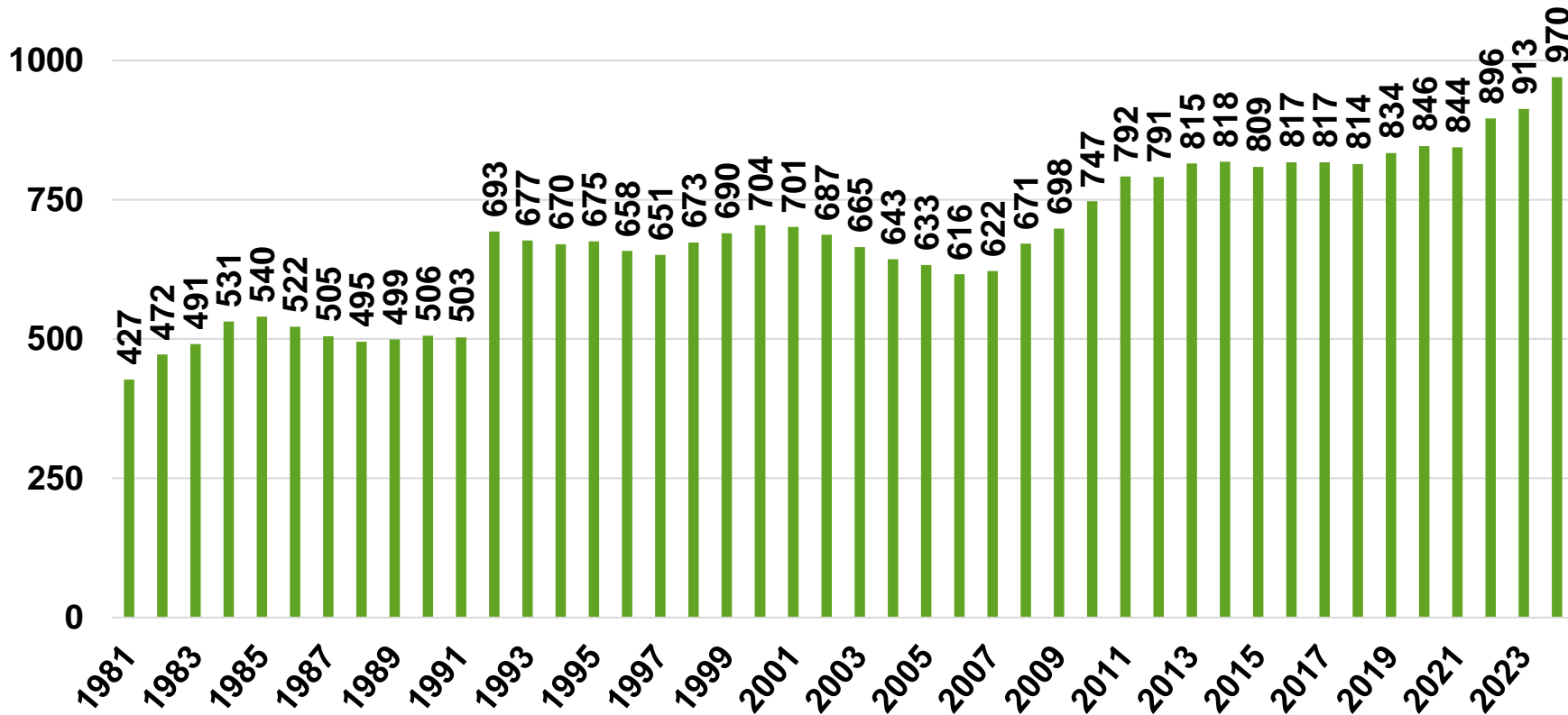

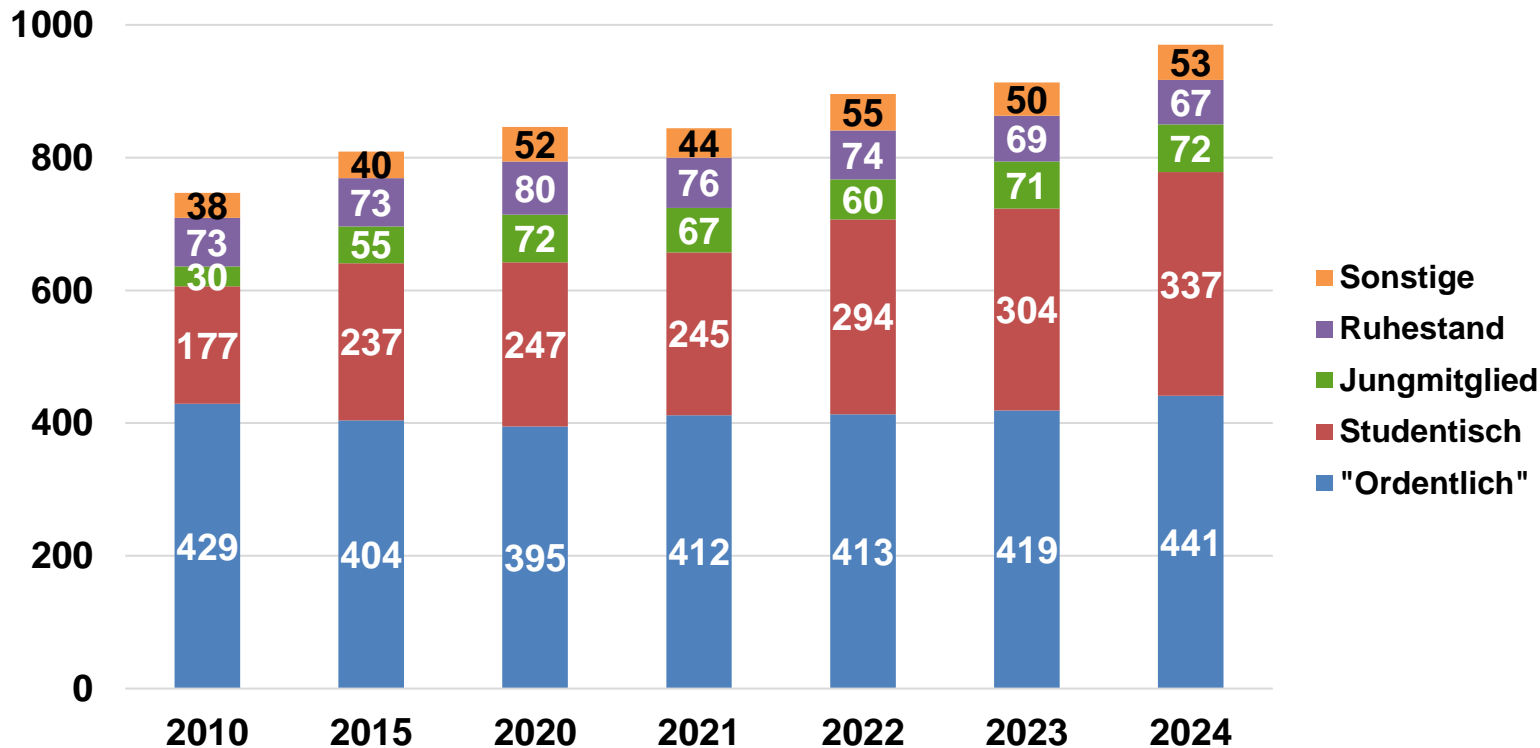

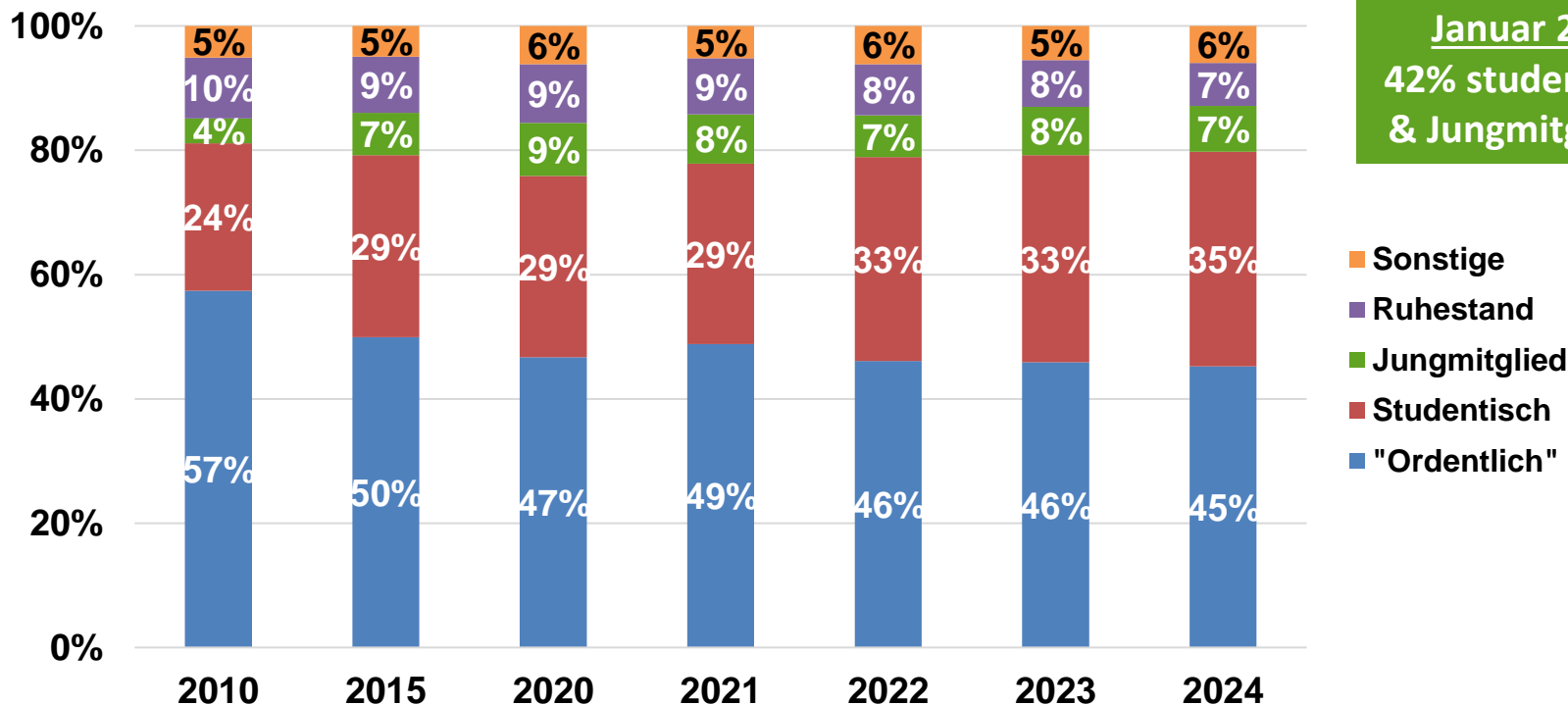
Mitglieder nach Beitragsklassen – 1 (absolut; jeweils zum 01.01. d.J.)

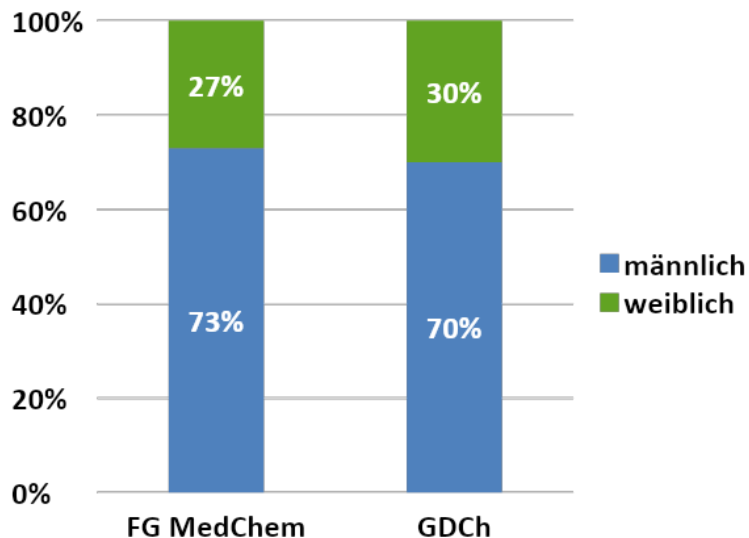

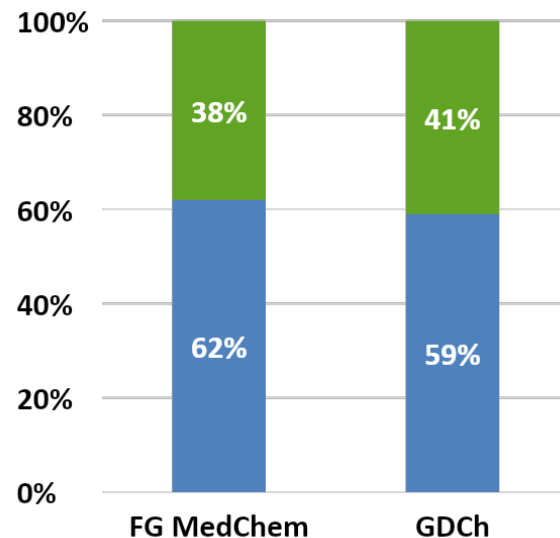

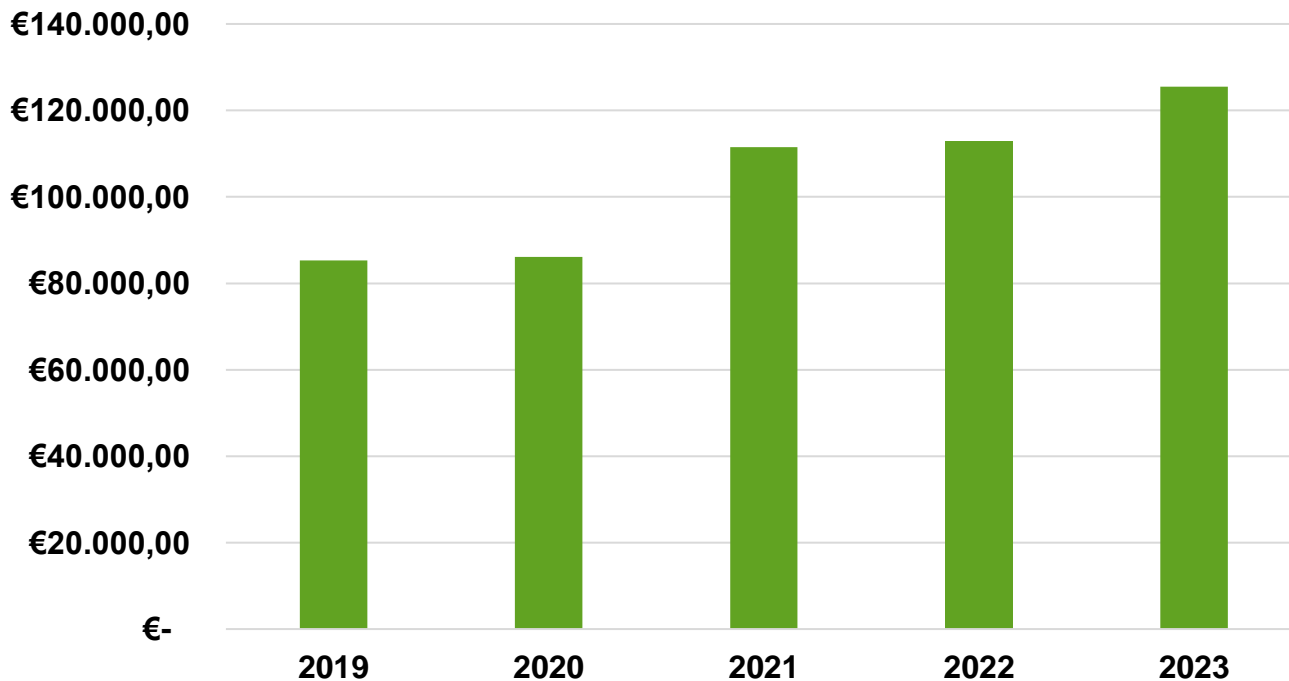
