# **GDCh Foundation Awards – Call for Nominations**

The following Foundations administered by the German Chemical Society (GDCh) will award prizes in 2013.

#### **Klaus Grohe Prize**

The "Klaus Grohe Foundation" established with the German Chemical Society (GDCh), awards the Klaus Grohe Prize to outstanding young scientists (post graduate students and postdoctoral researchers up to three years after having completed their doctorate) working in the field of medicinal chemistry and drug research at research institutes in Germany or other European countries. In general, the prize winners should have some connection to medicinal chemistry/drug research in Germany.

The prize is endowed with 2,000 Euro.

# **Hellmut Bredereck Foundation Prize**

The "Hellmut Bredereck Foundation" supports young scientists, who are active in the former fields of Professor H. Bredereck (1904 – 1981), namely organic and bioorganic chemistry with a focus on carbohydrates as well as heterocycles, proteins, and nucleotides. The prize winner will receive a certificate and 2,000 Euro.

## **Dr. Hermann Schnell Scholarships**

The "Dr. Hermann Schnell Stiftung" supports young scientists in the field of macromolecular chemistry, its physico-chemical fundamentals, and its analysis. Support will be given to postgraduates from universities or other institutions under public law. Partial scholarships for participating in important scientific meetings are also on offer. Scholarships up to 6,000 Euro are available.

The Foundation prizes will be awarded during the Foundation Symposium at the GDCh Chemistry Forum, September 1 – 4, 2009, in Darmstadt.

Proposals should consist of a letter in support of the nomination (self-nominations are welcome), a curriculum vitae, and a list of publications.
